## Barkway Park Golf Club

### Local Rules

#### 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

A ball is Out of Bounds if it lies:

- a) Beyond any course boundary fence or hedge
- b) In or beyond any ditch bordering the course
- c) On or beyond any public road
- d) Beyond any line of white stakes denoting a boundary
- e) On or over the clubhouse buildings, artificial surfaces and car parks

#### 2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

All ditches and ponds on the course are to be treated as a red penalty area (identified by red stakes). Where there is an absence of stakes and not associated with an out of bounds condition, proceed as if red stakes were present.

##### Opposite Side Relief

When a ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area separating holes 1 and 9 and between the 2 bridges, as an extra relief option the player may drop a ball within 2 club lengths of the equidistant point on the opposite edge of the penalty area.

#### 3. Provisional Ball for Ball in a Penalty Area

If a player does not know whether the ball is in the penalty area, the player may play a provisional ball using any of the following relief options: stroke-and-distance relief option (see Rule 17.1d(1)), the back-on-the-line relief option (see Rule 17.1d(2)) or, the lateral relief option (see Rule 17.1d(3)).

#### 4. Prohibiting Play from Fringe of Wrong Green

When taking wrong green relief (Rule 13.1f) from any green, the wrong green is defined to include the area of fairway within two club-lengths from the edge of the putting green. This means when taking relief, the nearest point of complete relief must avoid interference from this area in addition to the wrong green.

#### 5. Ball Deflected by Power Line

If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line [or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line] during play, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.6).

#### 6. Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens

Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1.

The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play

Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is:

- On the line of play, and is:
  - o Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
  - o Within two club-lengths of the ball.

*Exception - No Relief If Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.*

Match Play: Loss of Hole

Stroke Play: 2-strokes
